

Privacy Policy for Alpex Legal B.V. (alpex.legal)

This is the privacy policy (the "Privacy Policy") for Alpex Legal B.V. ("Alpex", "we", "us" or "our") and its website alpex.legal. We are committed to protecting the privacy of our users ("you" or "your"). This Privacy Policy explains how we collect, use, protect and disclose information and data when you use the alpex.legal website as well as during the provision of our legal advisory services to you (the "Service"). We respect your privacy and only process personal data in accordance with the GDPR (EU) 2016/679.

1. Information Collection

3. Sharing of Personal Data

- As a result of a legitimate interest.
- With your consent.

We may share your Personal Data with third-party suppliers. This may be the case in the event of third parties that are relevant for the provision of our services, such as other attorneys, advisors, courts or in the event of third parties such as IT suppliers. When we share Personal Data with third-party suppliers, these third parties have access to your Personal Data. The reason is to perform the tasks assigned to them on our behalf.



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4. Data Security

We value your trust in providing us your Personal Data. To that end, we implement adequate security measures to protect your information from unauthorized access, alteration, disclosure or destruction.

5. Retention periods

We do not retain Personal Data longer than necessary for the purposes for which we process such Personal Data, taking into account the relevant retention periods in applicable laws, regulations and rules for professional conduct.

You have certain rights regarding the Personal Data we hold about you. These may include the right to access, correct, delete, or restrict the use of your Personal Data, or to object to certain uses.
